CAMP RULES & DRESS CODE:

- Christian conduct is expected at all times. No disrespect to any staff member. Be considerate of other campers.
- No radios, audio players, electronic games, cell phones, tobacco products, illegal drugs, fireworks, air-soft gun/paintball gun or any other recreational gun, knives, weapons of any kind or any other inappropriate items. Any of these items will be taken up and returned to the parents at the end of camp.
- All medication must be in its original container and checked in to the Camp Medic at check-in.
- Campers will be charged for any property that is damaged either deliberately or as the result of unauthorized activities.
- Dress is casual. Jeans and t-shirts are great. Shorts are to be an appropriate length for modesty. No cut off or see thru shirts. No writing on the rear of clothing. Boys, no sagging of pants. No sleeveless shirts, spaghetti strips, bare midriffs. Only 1 piece swimsuits for girls and boxer style for boys. Shorts can be worn for swimsuits. Cover-ups must be worn from dorm, to and from the lake. The Dress Code will be followed at all times.
- Campers are not permitted at the Lake without supervision.

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PRIVILEGE TO VISIT AND USE TEXOMA YOUTH CAMP, I HEREBY EXPRESSLY RELEASE, WANE, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY TEXOMA YOUTH CAMP {"CAMP"} AND ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, OTHER CAMP USERS, AND REPRESENTATIVES AND THEIR FAMILIES, HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FROM ANY AND ALL ACCIDENTS OR MISHAPS OF ANY NATURE WHICH RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, PAIN OR DAMAGE TO ANY PERSONS OR DAMAGE TO ANY PROPERTY ARISING FROM, OR IN ANY MANNER RELATED TO, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, MY OR MY MINOR CHILD{REN}_S RECREATIONAL, SOCIAL, OR OTHER ACTIVITIES IN ANY FORM {SPECIFICALLY FISHING, CAMPING, BOATING, ATHLETICS, SWIMMING. Dress Code

Dress in keeping with the highest Christian standards while at camp. We value modesty in all situations. Wear proper footwear to avoid insect bites or injury. Please respect the guidelines when packing for camp. The staff will abide by these guidelines as well.



Dress casual. Jeans and t-shirts are great. Shorts are great too, but must be an appropriate length for modesty. Capris are a great choice anytime.



Dress casual. Jeans and t-shirts are great.



No bikinis or 2 piece swimsuits. Cover-ups must be worn from dorm, to and from the lake.



No tight - shirts, sweaters, pants or shorts. No sleeveless shirts, undershirts or cut-off shirts.

Boxer-style swimsuits only. Shorts can be worn for swimsuits.



No sleeveless shirts, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, halter tops or tube tops. No see through shirts. No shirts or sweaters that are low cut or are too tight.



Boys or Girls - No writing on the rear of clothing. No cult or occult symbols on front or back of clothing.

No tight shorts or short shorts.



No short skirts or low-cut tops.



Boys - rear view - keep your pants pulled up. All clothing must fit at the waist.



Girls can wear dresses or skirts if they want to, but must be appropriate length for modesty.
